### **Laurent Galzy**

Born on 14 May 1957 in Montpellier, Laurent Galzy is a graduate of the HEC School of Management and the IEP (Institute of Political Studies) in Paris, and holds a Masters' Degree in Economics. He is also a former pupil of the ENA (National School of Administration).

Since 1984, he has held several budget management posts (Ministry of the Economy and Finance) in the areas of infrastructure, transport, and territorial or local authority development.

In 1999, he became deputy director of the "Industry, Transport and Research" Subdivision of the Budget Management department.

He came to Aéroports de Paris in 2002, holding the post of Director of Management Control and Financial and Legal Affairs, and later the post of Executive Director of Finance and Administration.

### **Edward Arkwright**

Born on 26 April 1974, Edward Arkwright is a graduate of the IEP in Paris and studied at the ESSEC Business School. He also holds a Master of Advanced Studies in Modern History. In 1999, he became a member of the Senate Finance Committee. From 2002 to 2007, he held several positions at the Ministry of Finance in charge of the implementation of the budgetary reform initiated by the organic law relating to financial legislation (LOLF), the State Reform and public finance. In 2007, he was principal private Secretary to the General Director of the Caisse des Dépôts Group. In 2010, he became Strategy Director for the Caisse des Dépôts Group. When he came to Aéroports de Paris in December 2012, his first appointment was as Special Advisor to the Chairman & CEO of Aéroports de Paris.

As of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013, Edward Arkwright has been appointed as Executive Director of Finance and Strategy.

### **Didier Hamon**

Born on 5 September 1951 in Paris, Didier Hamon is a graduate of the IEP in Paris and Wharton (University of Pennsylvania). He holds a Master's Degree in Law and studied at the French National School for the Judiciary. He was Deputy State Prosecutor firstly for Val d'Oise and then Hauts de Seine, General Secretary of the National School of Industrial Design and programme director for the Bicentenary of the French Revolution.

He was Senior Lecturer at the IEP in Paris for eight years, and associate professor at the University of Versailles.

After 5 years of ministerial office (principal secretary and advisor to Jack Lang then Jean-Louis Bianco), Didier Hamon joined Aéroports de Paris in 1993 as Communications Director, the company spokesperson. In 2003, he became Environment and Sustainability Director.

Didier Hamon has been appointed as General Secretary of the group.

### **Pascal Bourgue**

Born on 20 September 1950, Pascal Bourgue holds a doctorate in corporate management from Paris-Dauphine and is a graduate of the Institut d'Etudes Politiques in Bordeaux. In 1977, he began his career at Automobiles Peugeot as manager of Strategy and Market Research. He moved to SNCF in 1987 as Assistant Marketing Director, and then became Main Line Communications Director. In 1998, he was appointed as Communications Director for the "9 Telecom" Group, a subsidiary of Bouygues. He joined the AGF (Assurances Générales de France) in 2001 as Communications Director. ### **Benjamin Perret**
