The new version of the application is also more user-friendly and has improved graphics and technical features.

Available from Apple Store and Google Play, *My Airport* provides access to flight information in real time and offers up a host of useful tips: opening hours, car parking comparison, route planner, handy phone numbers, procedures, business services, etc.
