Vailog signs a building lease with Aéroports de Paris to set up a freight facility and an office building with a total surface area of 8,500 sqm for Dachser France at Paris-Orly Airport

Vailog has signed a building lease with Aéroports de Paris for the creation of a freight facility and an office building of 8,500 sqm located in the town of Wissous in the département of Essonne, thus benefiting from the substantial road transport infrastructure that has been developed around Paris-Orly Airport.

For this building project, Aéroports de Paris is the planner for approximately 4.2 hectares of land, with Vailog in the role of developer/investor. Dachser and Aéroports de Paris are receiving advice on this transaction from CBRE.



The whole of this new building programme is intended for the international logistics provider Dachser France. From the first quarter of 2015, Dachser will enjoy the use of a freight facility boasting the latest technical and technological equipment. Capable of handling over 125,000 tonnes of palletised freight per year, it will be well-positioned to conquer new market share.

The new facility will run alongside the existing logistics warehouses used by certain groups (Fnac, Casino, etc.) located in the Vendavel park to the south-west of the airport.
