Unless otherwise indicated, the following changes are expressed in comparison with the same period in 2024.

May 2025 traffic:

- Group traffic1: 32.4 million passengers, up +2.7%;
- Paris Aéroport's traffic: 9.4 million passengers, up +3.3%.
